Style Category:

Contemporary Day - Ladies.

The competitor will be executing a cut and style on a female model whose hair has been pre-colored using a minimum of two colors. This design should be acceptable by the majority of female consumer's who are contemporary and follow trends.

The combination of technical excellence in the cut, the choice and placement of color and the finishing are important design elements in creating a winning look.

Competition Time: 45 minutes

Prep Work:

Competitors will report with
models at appointed time.

Models must be pre-colored with a
minimum of 2 colors.

The choice of colors and
placement is a vital part of this
competition and should reinforce
the hair cut.

Model's hair must be evenly wet
throughout and combed straight
back before the competition
begins.

One inch of hair must be cut
throughout the head during the
competition. Failure to do so will
result in penalty points assessed.

Tools and Products:

Any haircutting tools and clippers may
be used.

All styling and finishing products are
permitted. Any combs, brushes, clips
or hand held electrical tools are
allowed to achieve the finished look.

(1) one electrical outlet will be
provided for each competitor. Only (1)
one electric appliance may be plugged
in at any one time. No tool drawing
more than 1950 watts may be used.

Clothing: While this is not to be
considered a total look competition,
the attire of the model should fit with
the overall theme of the competition.
Sages will however assess penalty for
indecent attire.

Penalty Points: See general
rules for all other regulations and
penalty assessments.

Judging and Awards:

Judging will take place immediately
following competitors leaving the
competition arena. Announcement of
winners and awards will take place
following the judging. Time and place
will be given at competitors briefing.

General Rules for Competition

1. Entry fee of 75.00 must accompany all applications and be received by the deadline.
2. Competition is open to all licensed cosmetologist and licensed barbers and proof of licensure may be required.
3. Competition must be done on a live model, no mannequins are permitted.
4. All contestants and models must sign a release form allowing photos and video images to be used.
5. Competitors must sign in at least 30 minutes prior to start of competition.
6. All questions about the rules or circumstances not covered by the rules will be answered during the briefing session prior to the competition.
7. The CBI Management reserves the right to reject any entry it deems unqualified and to cancel and/or not award cash prizes if a minimum number of competitors is not reached.
8. Models must refrain from assisting and/or coaching the competitor.
9. Competitors will provide their own mirror and cape for use during competition.
10. All competitors are responsible for their own personal belongings and must leave the competition arena clean before judging may begin.
11. CBI Management will not be responsible for items lost, stolen, or left behind by competitors or models.
12. Judging will be done on a visual basis only.
13. The International 30-point scoring system will be used by the judges. This is a computerized numerical scoring system used by all major cosmetology competitions throughout the world. Maximum - 30 pts Minimum - 20 pts
14. Judging will be based on the following criteria:
 - a) Structural Form and Execution—shape, balance, hair to face relationship
 - b) Workmanship—clear precise work, neatness, details, quality of work
 - c) Originality in design—creativity, harmony of textures and colors

Penalty Points That May Be Assessed

Coaching— verbal or nonverbal assistance to competitor by any person

Hairstyle out of category— design does not reflect stated objective of contest

Over preparation— Excessive preparation, giving competitor an unfair advantage

Electrical Restrictions— not adhering to usage as stated in rules

Non-respect of Time Stop—any competitor continuing to work after time is called

Sages on the competition floor will give penalty points. Competition Chairman will review point assessments and a collective majority will result in the final penalties to be handed to the tabulator for deduction from final score.
